The second annual *AZ Walk to Silence Tinnitus* will take place on Saturday, March 24, 2012 at beautiful DC Ranch in Scottsdale. This 5K event hosted by the American Tinnitus Association (ATA) is coordinated and sponsored by Arizona health professionals and patients who both treat and have tinnitus. In addition to severely impacting over 16 million people in the United States, tinnitus is also the number one service-connected disability affecting United States veterans. While there are treatments that work for some people, there is currently no cure.

WHAT: The 2nd Annual AZ Walk to Silence Tinnitus

WHEN: Saturday, March 24, 2012 at 8 a.m.

WHERE: Market Street at DC Ranch, in Scottsdale

WHY: To raise research funds for tinnitus, commonly referred to as “ringing in the ears.” Tinnitus robs silence from 16 million people in the United States who suffer from chronic, unrelenting tinnitus.

In addition to the 5K Walk, we will have vendors participating with booths, including local tinnitus health professionals and device manufacturers, who will be on-hand to answer your tinnitus-related questions. There will also be a raffle at the conclusion of the Walk, where participants can win prizes from Phoenix metro-area businesses.
